- Introduce, discuss and clarify the meaning of "empathy" in arts, which has important implications for artistic research, training and practice.
- Clarify and demonstrate how empathy as an abstract concept can be applied in the arts so that people are motivated to care for non-human others and the environment by using concrete examples.
- Support artists and cultural professionals to engage with mainstream research from philosophy, social sciences and sustainability studies on the role of empathy and perspective-taking in advocating for environmental issues.

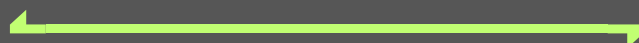
